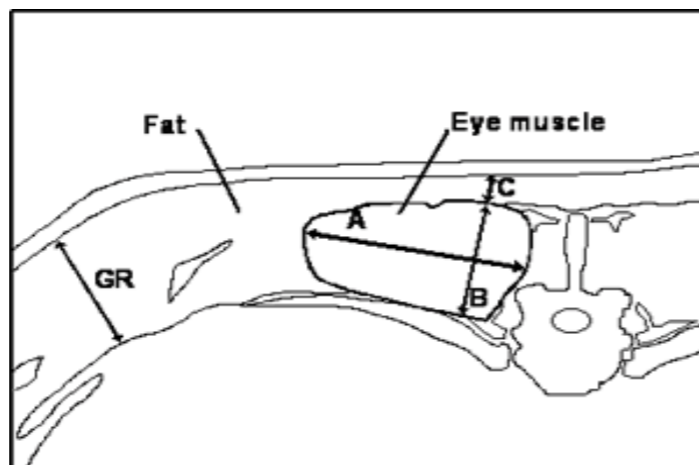

Ultrasonic scanning of the 12th rib muscle gives the width of the eye muscle **(A)**, the depth of the eye muscle **(B)**, and the depth of fat between the eye muscle and the skin **(C)**. This allows the calculation of the eye muscle area **(EMA)**.



The **Meat Index** is a means of ranking the young sheep within the stud by liveweight, eye muscle dimensions and fat depth. The formula used adds value for bigger eye muscle dimensions and subtracts value for excessive fat depth. More emphasis is given to Eye Muscle Width than Eye Muscle Depth as muscle width is more to do with the genetics of the sheep e.g. shape and leanness whereas depth is associated with the environment e.g. feeding, stress etc. The higher the index the better.

Ovine Brucellosis Accreditation

Ovine brucellosis is an infection of the testicles which results in infertility in rams. It is easily spread from infected to uninfected rams resulting in lower lambing percentages. There is no practical individual ram treatment. Sire rams from brucellosis-accredited studs undergo blood tests every 1 to 3 years to detect the presence of this disease. By buying rams from brucellosis accredited studs you are sure of not introducing this to your enterprise.

Having succeeded in producing rams that will sire lambs that are fast growing with excellent length, we are now focusing on increasing even more the muscling on the loin and hind quarter. This is the profit-driver for lamb producers. This objective is reflected in the rams that we buy and the rams we choose to keep from our stud.

The other profit-driver is the number of lambs safely produced. Our rams are smooth through the shoulder for easier delivery and 2/3 of the rams for sale are multiple births which is an inheritable trait.

Our lambs are weighed within 12 hours of birth, at weaning and at 7 months of age (to correspond with the Australian Sheep Breeding Values (ASBV) BWT, WWT and PWT). These weights are then graphed so that the growth trend of the individual ram is easily identified.

This is combined with Stockscan to select the sale rams and validates the visual traits we identify as necessary for top class stock. **The Stockscan results shown are from June 2019** and are the best and most consistent we have achieved.

The rams were drenched with **Cydectin LV SE** and vaccinated with **Glanvac 6 in 1** on **5/9/2019**.

Rosewood Sire Rams

Hildden 850-12

Tremendously well-balanced and muscled ram of the Hildden 800 line. Has 'clicked' very well with ewes to produce some very impressive fast growing lambs.

Rosewood 345-16

Son of Hildden 850-12. Inherited the balance and muscle of his father with even more size. Placed 4th at the NSW Poll Dorset Championship.

Hildden 77-14

Full brother to Hildden 123-10 who was Supreme Champion at Canberra, Sydney, Bendigo and the NSW Dorset Championship. Purchased for \$10000. Structurally correct and with tremendous muscling.

Rosewood 105-17

Son of Hildden 77-14. Born a triplet. Threw the highest indexed Spring lamb.

Abelene Park 176-12

Purchased as a 10 month old weighing 128kg. Has tremendous length, height and neck extension. Bare breeched. Purchased with the aim of combining his attributes with the muscle and growth of the stud ewes.

Rosewood 11-14

Son of Abelene Park. He has inherited his father's height and stretch and early maturity as well as adding impressive muscling in the loin and hind quarters.

Rosewood 6-13

Son of Hildden 151-10 from the Hildden 300 line. Inherited the length, height and muscling of his father. Born a quad he has sired many multiple birth lambs that demonstrate early growth, great body length and depth as well as impressive eye muscling.

Rosewood 8-13

From our Tattykeel ram. Combines the bulk of his sire with the length and height of his dam's Gererdan Eclipse line. Sire of the 2017 Grand Champion ewe at the NSW Dorset Championship demonstrating his compatibility with our Abelene Park sired ewes.

Rosewood 317-16

Son of Rosewood 8-13. Born a twin. Also placed 4th in his class at the NSW Poll Dorset Championship. Weighed 80kg at 7 months old.

Hildden 296-16

Son of the Senior Champion at the NSW Dorset Championship 2015 and the Australian Sheep and Wool Championship in Bendigo he shows great style, muscle and length. We use him as the model for our current newspaper adverts.

Since its foundation we have aimed to improve body structure (length and depth), productivity (eye muscle and wool production) and produce early maturing lambs. This is reflected in the first cross ewes.

Our established clients have been very happy with the rams' performance and longevity.

In 2017 we purchased an excellent new sire from Retallack. This will complement the rams purchased in 2015 from Bauer Stud (J & T Buerckner, Temora) which won the Objective Measurement class at Sydney Royal and was Junior Champion, and the stud sire from Bindaree (R & R Sweeny, Merrygoen). This ram has great body length and depth.

We have recorded an increase in Stockscan measurement averages since introducing these sires into our Stud flock. This year's offering of sale rams is pleasing considering the seasonal conditions

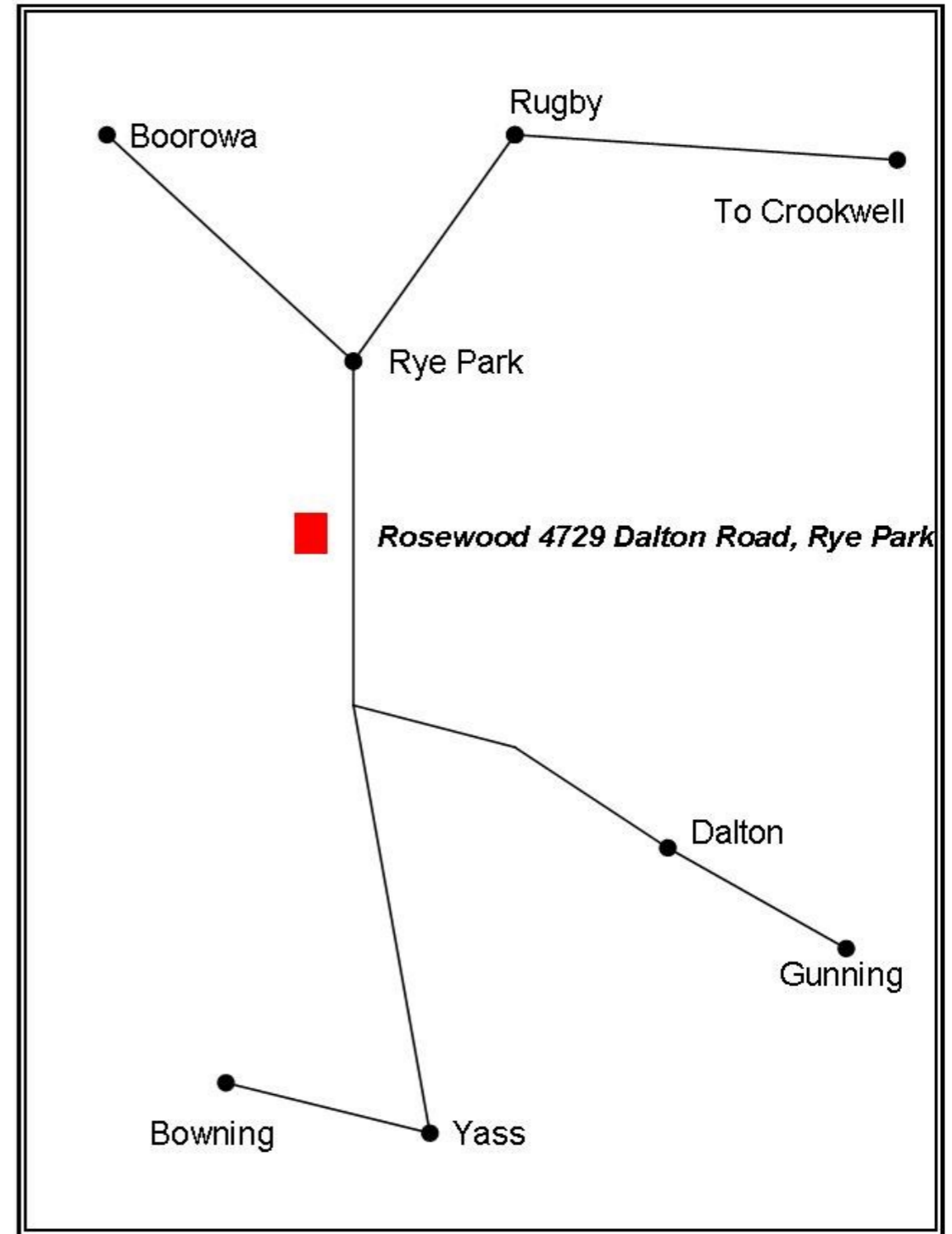
